Redzone Resources Ltd. (“REZ” or the “Company”) reports that it has filed its unaudited condensed interim consolidated financial statements for the three and nine months ended January 31, 2014 and the related management’s discussion and analysis (“MD&A”).

The Company reported a net loss for the three and nine months ended January 31, 2014 and 2013 of \$0.5 million and \$0.8 million respectively.

The Company has \$1.0 million in cash and remains active in its search for a value adding acquisition to see the Company to its goal of being a mid-tier mining company. The Lara property has a drill program in place for 3,000 meters of infill to reach an inferred resource and many additional exploration targets have been identified. The Company continues to wait for improved market conditions to move the project forward.
